# NEW HAVEN SENIORS RECEIVED \$271,700, WITH AN ADDITIONAL \$60,000 AWARDED TO CONTINUING SCHOLARS!

As the cost of Higher Education rises, donations received by the New Haven Scholarship Fund (NHSF) are crucial in supporting New Haven students in their quest to pursue a college degree. "Our philosophy has always been 'we'll get you started," said NHSF President Jeffrey Alpert. The NHSF has been awarding scholarships to New Haven students since 1959 when Hillhouse High math teacher Jean Paton Lovell raised enough money to award eight \$100 scholarships. Since then, through the generosity of its donors, the fund has awarded more than \$9 million to more than 8,000 New Haven students. This year, 197 High School Seniors received \$271,700 at a reception at Career High School. Continuing Scholars also received \$60,000 to support their studies.
